



You Run This Town Foundation - Orange County 2021/2022 Scholarship Application

You Run This Town Foundation OC (YRTTF OC) is committed to develop the next generation of leaders by providing scholarships to outstanding scholars. YRTTF OC offers college and trade school scholarships in the amount of \$1000 to qualified graduating high school seniors and eligible college students who will attend a community college, 4-year university, or trade school in the fall of 2021. In the Spring of **2021**, our Scholarship Committee will award \$1000 scholarships to outstanding students who have participated in our enrichment programs through our partnering organizations.

APPLICATION GUIDELINES AND PRIORITIES

For an application to be considered, ALL of the following required supporting documents must be submitted. Please read ALL instructions carefully as incomplete applications will NOT be considered.

1. Applicant must be a graduating high school senior **and/or** an eligible college or trade school bound student who is currently working with one of YRTTF OC partnering agencies and has participated in ALL of YRTTF OC 2020/21 enrichment program video workshops and completed the assessment at the end of each workshop. *
2. Applicant must have a minimum 2.5 GPA. Transcripts are required as proof of the student's GPA.
3. Applicant must submit an essay closely following the requested prompt.
4. Applicant must provide ONE (1) letter of recommendation from educational professionals or other professionals (i.e. volunteer/extracurricular or job supervisor). Recommendations from family members will NOT be accepted.
5. Applicant must provide an updated Resume and/or Cover Letter.
6. Applicant must have completed a minimum of TEN (10) hours of volunteer hours (see attached form).
7. Applicant must provide letter of acceptance/admission/registration at College, University, Trade school or Vocational Institution.
8. Applications must be received by the You Run This Town Foundation OC Chapter Scholarship Committee no later than **Friday, March 26, 2021**. Late applications will not be accepted!

- If an applicant is selected to receive a scholarship, he/she will be honored at an award ceremony in Spring/Summer 2021 (details to follow).
- Upon receiving the award, YRTTF OC will mail funds directly to student's college of attendance.
